- ♥ **Praise** - Praising God for **who He is**, His attributes, His name, or His character. Please no answers to prayer or prayer requests during this time.

Theme: Jesus, having endured, is now seated at the right hand of God

Scripture(s) For us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live. (1 Cor. 8:6) ³ The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. ⁴ So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs. (Heb. 1:3-4)

- ♥ **Confession** - Silent prayer time.

The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart. (1 Sam. 16:7)

- ♥ **Thanksgiving** - Thanking God for answers to prayer. Please no prayer requests during this time.
