- ♥ **Praise** - Praising God for **who He is**, His attributes, His name, or His character. Please no answers to prayer or prayer requests during this time.

Attribute **WORD** Definition The divine incarnation of God's thoughts toward us, expressed in human form.

Scripture(s): The **Word** became flesh and made his dwelling among us. (John 1:14) The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful **word**. (Heb. 1:3) He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the **Word** of God. (Rev. 19:13)

- ♥ **Confession** - Silent prayer time.

For the **word** of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. (Heb. 4:12)

- ♥ **Thanksgiving** - Thanking God for answers to prayer. Please no prayer requests during this time.

- ♥ **Intercession** - Form groups of two or as comfortable.
